WHAT A HEALTHY NEWBORN LOOKS LIKE

The body - a short neck, sloping shoulders, swollen breasts, large rounded abdomen, umbilical stump, slender narrow pelvis and hips. Weight 6–9 lbs. Length 18 – 22 inches.

The skin - dry and thin, often revealing veins. Fair skin may be rosy-red temporarily. African American babies are fair-skinned until darker pigment settles through the skin. Downy hair is not unusual, nor is peeling, particularly around the hands and feet. Veins on the head swell and throb.

The head - seems too big for the body. It may be temporarily out of shape, possibly lopsided or elongated due to pressure before or during birth. A bald head or thick crop of hair are both normal.

The skull - you can see or feel two soft spots or fontanel, one above the brow, the second close to the crown of the head. The scalp skin may be loose and the brow wrinkled.

The eyes - not fully developed. You may notice one or both eyes turning to a cross-eyed position. Eyelids may be puffy. You won't see tears as the tear ducts don't function yet.

The face – pudgy cheeks, broad flat nose, receding chin and slightly under slung jaw are not unusual.

The hands - usually held in a fist position. When opened, they show finely lined palms, tissue paper-thin nails, dry, loose-fitting skin and deep, bracelet-like wrist creases.

Genitals - of both sexes may seem large (especially the scrotum) in comparison to the baby's overall size.

The legs - most often seen drawn up against the abdomen. Extended legs are shorter than you would expect compared to the arms. They are a bit bowed.

The feet - look more complete than they are. In actuality, only bone exists in the heel. Other future bones are not cartilage.

BABY'S HEARING TIMETABLE

<u>Age</u>	<u>General Characteristics</u>
<i>0-3 months</i>	<i>Is startled by loud noises. Is soothed by parents' voices.</i>
<i>3-6 months</i>	<i>Turns eyes & head to search for sounds. Imitates own sounds – oohs, babas, etc. Enjoys sound making toys, i.e. rattles</i>
<i>6-10 months</i>	<i>Responds to name, phone & soft voices.</i>
<i>10-15 months</i>	<i>Can point to or look at familiar objects when named. Begins to imitate simple words & sounds.</i>
<i>15-18 months</i>	<i>Follows simple spoken directions. Begins using first words. By 18 months is using many new words.</i>

BABY'S TALKING TIMETABLE

<u>Age</u>	<u>General Characteristics</u>
<i>1-4 weeks</i>	<i>Crying is the beginning of using the voice. Engages in crying which has no apparent purpose or meaning.</i>
<i>1-3 months</i>	<i>Differentiates cries to show pleasure or distress. Coos.</i>
<i>4-6 months</i>	<i>Able to babble, laugh, chuckle, or gurgle.</i>
<i>6-9 months</i>	<i>Repeats sounds made by parents. Changes pitch & inflection of sounds.</i>
<i>9-12 months</i>	<i>Repeats words spoken by parents. First words may appear.</i>
<i>12-18 months</i>	<i>Beginning of true speech Vocabulary of 1 to 20 words.</i>
