

Conscious Fathering

Conscious Fathering is a free, 1-1/2 hour class for new and expectant fathers to discuss and practice the skills needed to nurture and care for your baby.

Based on the Conscious Fathering[™] curriculum, the program provides hands-on training in a comfortable setting using life-size dolls. Participants learn how to handle, feed, burp, change, clean and calm their newborn infant. Discussion also includes what to expect in upcoming months.
